## **PRIOR TO THE DAY**

## **EXPECTATIONS OF STUDENTS**

1. The expectation is that students will have a basic knowledge of the instrument they are playing.
2. The aim of the day is for students to be involved in a “mass concert” and performance. It is hoped that they will learn the skills required to perform as part of the mass concert, to learn from their tutors and to enjoy the experience with other students from other Christian Schools.
3. Obviously there will be a variety of student abilities on the day. It is expected that all students will cooperate, encourage and enjoy each other’s abilities.
4. Students need to bring their own lunch each day. CSEN will supply a pizza dinner the concert evening. Maranatha does not have a canteen available onsite, however Hillcrest does and students are welcome to purchase lunch there on the concert date.
