The school that wins the overall competition will be awarded the Word Play shield. Each student in the winning team will receive a First Place certificate.

WHAT IS WORDPLAY?

If you like to play with words, lop around the sweaters or wix your murds, then it's time to put pen to paper and compete in CSEN's 'Word Play'.

Focusing on the works of Dr Seuss, a team of 15 students from your school (3 teams of 5) will compete in Seuss-related challenges – from alliteration and pangrams to beat boxing foxes in boxes and loquacious loraxes.

The competition has 3 rounds of challenges, each utilising a story from literary 'Seussiety' and focusing on a particular area of literacy. Then each group is set the task to write and create the most original piece within the style of 'Horton Hears a Who', 'The Cat In The Hat' or on a wander down 'Mulberry Street'... just to name a few.

So organise a team of 15 and enter. Hosted by Allen Dickson, it's sure to be a day where you'll be counting your words and making sure your words count!



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RULES

1. Schools enter up to 3 teams of 5 students in Primary Word Play.
2. The intention of the day is for schools / students to compete to the best of their ability in a friendly, encouraging Christian setting.
3. Electronic equipment must not be accessed during the competitions. It is preferred that these devices are not brought to CSEN Word Play.
4. All competing teams must have a teacher / staff member with them.

PROCEDURES FOR THE COMPETITION

Start of the day

All students will meet at the beginning of the day for a briefing on rules as well as prayer.

Scoring Procedure – to be updated

1. The aggregate of the students from each school team will determine the schools score for the day. The school with the most points will be declared the winner of CSEN Word Play.
2. In the event of a tie, the result will stand and the schools will share the Championship.

Final Procedures

It is expected that at the conclusion of the day, all schools will remain for presentations and a closing prayer.

OTHER INFORMATION

1. CSEN will provide lunch for staff on the day. Unfortunately food allergies / intolerances cannot be catered for.
2. Students are expected to provide their own lunch / snacks for the day. Belgrave Heights and Victory have an on – site canteen that students may access. There is no canteen at Maranatha Officer.
3. All schools are expected to leave the facilities at Belgrave Heights, Maranatha Officer and Victory neat and tidy. Excess cleaning costs will be passed onto the schools that leave their area in an unacceptable state.
